Code of Conduct for Players

Conquerors Junior Netball Club, in its continuing effort to increase the enjoyment and participation of the game of netball has introduced a Players' Code of Conduct. We ask all those involved in netball follow these guidelines to ensure that all games and tournaments are played in the best spirit of the game.

- 1. Be conversant and observe the rules of the game.
- 2. Play fairly, be competitive but not aggressive.
- 3. During play do not question a decision by the umpires either by gesture, look, verbally or by commenting to another player. Be respectful to all players and officials.
- 4. Respects your coach and their decision and be assured they are always ready to listen to you if you have any concerns or questions.
- 5. Give the ball promptly to opponents' throw-ins, penalty shots, free and penalty passes etc.
- 6. Ensure you are in the correct position indicated by the umpire when penalties are set.
- 7. Keep your self-control at all times and do not retaliate. Do not use obscene language at any time, and no physical contact.
- 8. Accept victory modestly and defeat graciously, you are representing your club who will be judged on your behaviour.
- 9. Acknowledge your opponents at the end of the game, regardless of the outcome.
- 10. Thank your Captain, Coach and Parent after your match.

<u>Conquerors Junior Netball Club</u> <u>Code of Conduct for Parents, Cares and Supporters</u>

Conquerors Junior Netball Club, in its continuing effort to increase the enjoyment and participation of the game of netball has introduced a Code of Conduct. We ask all those involved in netball follow these guidelines to ensure that all games and tournaments are played in the best spirit of the game and breaching of these rules could mean that your daughter may be asked to leave the club.

- 1. Do not force unwilling children to participate in netball, remember children are involved in netball for their enjoyment not yours.
- 2. Encourage your child to play to the rules and not to argue with umpires or other officials.
- Teach your child that honest effort is more important than victory, so the result of the game is accepted without undue disappointment. You are required to manage your daughters' expectations along with your own.
- 4. Turn losing into winning by helping your child work towards skill improvement and good sportsmanship.
- 5. Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a game.
- 6. Remember children learn best by example, applaud good play by your team or the opposition.
- 7. Do not question the umpire's decision or honesty, remember that they are only human with the same feelings as you and can sometimes make an honest mistake.
- 8. Recognise the importance and value of coaches who are all volunteers, they give children their time and resources to provide netball for your child.
- 9. Please ensure that you are respectful to member of the Chelmsford Junior Netball League, without this Committee we would not have a league.
- 10. Read the rules of netball to understand better what you are watching and commenting on.
- 11. Promote this Code of Conduct to other parents, cares and supporters.
- 12. If you daughter is selected for a team this does not guarantee court time. If you wish to discuss with the Coach, please ensure this is facilitated before or after the game.
- Coaches' decision on team selection and playing position should be supported at all times.
- 14. Any discussion you wish to have with your daughters coach should be in a calm and respectful manner.
- 15. Parents behaviour deemed abusive or unnecessary at training or matches could lead to your daughter being asked to leave Conquerors as this is not acceptable.
